

**ForeverGreen Council**  
**2010 Long Term Goals and Objectives (5 to 10 years)**

The long term goals are approved by the ForeverGreen Board of Directors and address long range planning of five years or more. They are reviewed on an annual basis and revised as needed. They are presented in no particular order.

1. Become the service organization to coordinate and assist in the building of multi-use and non-motorized trails in Pierce County.
2. Secure funding to support the budget of the ForeverGreen Council.
3. Raise public support to provide long-term trail and open space funding through a countywide bond or levy.
4. Raise public support for pedestrian-oriented community design and as a connector to a countywide trail system.
5. Complete an east-west trail system from Puget Sound to Mount Rainier with the Foothills Rails-to-Trails as the backbone to connect Gig Harbor, Tacoma, and the Puyallup Valley communities.
6. Plan for a north-south trail system to connect University Place, Lakewood, Steilacoom, and Dupont with Ashford, Eatonville, and Graham and the Nisqually Valley trail system.
7. Plan for connections to trail systems in adjacent counties.
8. Assist in the development and organization of a unified trail maintenance system.
9. Advocate for the benefits of trails and open space in our community.
10. Help maintain and revise a master blueprint (e.g. a map) of the trail system backbone that all Pierce County communities buy into and support.
