

ForeverGreen Council
Short Term Goals and Objectives (2006 to July 2007)

The short term goals are approved by the ForeverGreen Board of Directors and address the upcoming time period of approximately 12 months. They are presented in no particular order.

1. Pass renewal and increase of countywide Conservation Assessment Fee and hire Trails Assistance Office staff.
2. Secure funding for the ForeverGreen budget.
3. Write job descriptions for Trails Advisory Office (TAO) staff positions.
4. Acquire office space for the TAO staff.
5. Strengthen partnerships with cities and community groups to build trails. Coordinate education efforts with the Pierce Conservation District (PCD) to increase city participation in conservation fees.
6. Support the PCD proposal to renew and increase the Conservation Assessment by the Pierce County Council in 2006.
7. Organize the Trails Advisory Committee to address trail issues and help set up priorities for initial trail projects.
8. Organize a Pierce County Trails Conference in fall 2006.
9. Develop a progress report to community trail advocates and supporters. Develop a contact list of interested parties.
10. Appoint committee chairs and complete work plans for each committee.
11. Plan and organize a winter board retreat for the purpose of completing a strategic plan.
12. Evaluate budget needs for the transition to a full TAO office staff and set budget goals for 2007.
13. Set uniform trail standards for (standards for signs and maintenance, etc.).
14. Prioritize and lobby for the completion of the trail from Puyallup to Tacoma.
