2007 Short Term Goals and Objectives

The short term goals are approved by the ForeverGreen Board of Directors and address the upcoming time period of approximately 12 months. They are presented in no particular order.

1. Pass renewal and increase of countywide Conservation Assessment Fee and hire Trails Assistance Office staff.
2. Secure funding for the ForeverGreen budget.
3. Write job descriptions for Trails Advisory Office (TAO) staff positions as need arises.
4. Acquire office space for the TAO staff.
5. Strengthen partnerships with cities and community groups to build trails. Coordinate education efforts with the Pierce Conservation District (PCD) to increase city participation in conservation fees.
6. Convene a minimum of two Trails Advisory Committee meetings to address trail issues and establish priorities for trail projects.
7. Organize a Pierce County Trails Conference in fall 2007.
8. Develop a progress report to community trail advocates and supporters. Develop a contact list of interested parties.
9. Plan and organize a winter board retreat.
10. Evaluate budget needs for the transition to a full TAO office staff and set budget goals for 2008.
11. Work with Pierce County and other jurisdictions to develop uniform trail standards.
12. Help publicize National Trail Day in Pierce County (e.g. Rainier to Ruston relay run on June 2, 2007).
13. Review 6-year transportation plans of local municipalities to ensure trails are included.
